

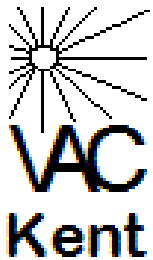

How a Remote Treatment Works

Basically, it works through a phenomenon called “entanglement” in Particle Physics. When two particles are said to be entangled, whatever happens to one, will happen to the other automatically no matter the distance apart they are. This is due to properties of magnetic fields.

When you create a magnetic field, the strength of the field diminishes with distance but the field itself extends out indefinitely. The indefinite reach is why entanglement happens. And why remote treatments are possible.

How I do a Remote Treatment

I first take a picture of the face of the person or animal I am going to treat. I then crop the picture to get a good view of the face. I then print it on my color printer. I have a 12 x 12 x ¼ inch aluminum plate (you could use a sheet of aluminum foil) that I then put the picture on. I have my machine hooked to the plate in such a way so when I run the treatment protocol, the current runs through the plate. That then creates a magnetic field surrounding the plate and engulfing the picture of the patient. Since the picture is of the patient, it captures the essence of that person or animal. It is best thought of as a “resonance” between the two. The similarity of resonance between the picture and patient is what connects

them. It doesn't matter where you are or what you are doing. That's the beauty of it. You can be at home, across town or on another continent. It doesn't matter. You could be at work, at home mowing the lawn or sleeping. No matter.

I have done over 600 remote treatments to date and usually they have an effect. I've treated dogs and a horse with good results.

I treated a dog who was diagnosed with colitis by the vet. There isn't a protocol for that that came with the software, so I had to design one myself. But I only had to run it 3 times and no more colitis!

Limitations of Remote Treatments

Since the magnetic field the patient is exposed to is quite small, they will not get the effects of microcurrent. Microcurrent increases the production of ATP in the mitochondria of the cells by 500%! ATP is the molecule the cell uses for energy, so this is very tonifying. So, if the effect of the treatment depends on the effect of microcurrent, a remote treatment will be of little use. You will get the effects of the frequencies but not the microcurrent. And that seems to be born out by my own experiences with it.

There are other ways to increase production of ATP besides microcurrent that I know of. For example, red light and near infrared (heat) is known to increase ATP. So, laying in the sun or using a hot tub or sauna will get a similar effect.

In addition, you could use methylene blue (a blue dye) as a supplement. It has the effect of correcting pretty much anything wrong with the four metabolic pathways that the mitochondria use to produce ATP. Doctors inject methylene blue to treat toxicities.

So, you can combine one of these with a remote treatment to make up for a remote treatment's lack of production of ATP.

Fees:

I Charge \$30.00 for 3 Treatments per week. That usually is enough to tell us if it is working or not.

If there is not an existing protocol and I have to design one myself, I charge an extra \$30.00.

About frequency Specific Microcurrent (FSM)

FSM is a needle-less form of electro-acupuncture. Specifically, it is a form of Inferential Electro-acupuncture although the F.D.A. licenses the machine as a form of TENS to treat pain. And it is good at treating many kinds of pain, even difficult cases. And all without needles! So, it's a great way to treat someone who is afraid of needles. This technique is based in research done in the 20's and 30's. In 1934, the A.M. A. decided that M.D.'s could only do drugs and surgery. Starting in 1995, Dr. McMakin, a chiropractor in Portland, started using it and developed the technique as it is today. Microcurrent in general has been proven by research to increase ATP (the energy source inside cells) by 500%! That's just from keeping the current below 500 microamps when using electrode pads and below 20 microamps when using needles. Then there's the effects of the frequencies. You put the frequency that's supposed to be associated with the tissue type involved with the condition is put in the first channel. The other channel is put to the frequency supposed to be

associated with the condition that the tissue is bothered by. If you guess correctly for both frequencies, you will treat that tissue with that problem. There are frequencies for many tissues and conditions. At least that's the theory. Of course, the FDA doesn't recognize any of this. Generally, if it works it works but rarely are there any negative effects. There are some generally pleasant side effects due to the increase of endorphins and serotonin that relax you and can make you feel kind of high. But acupuncture can do that too.
